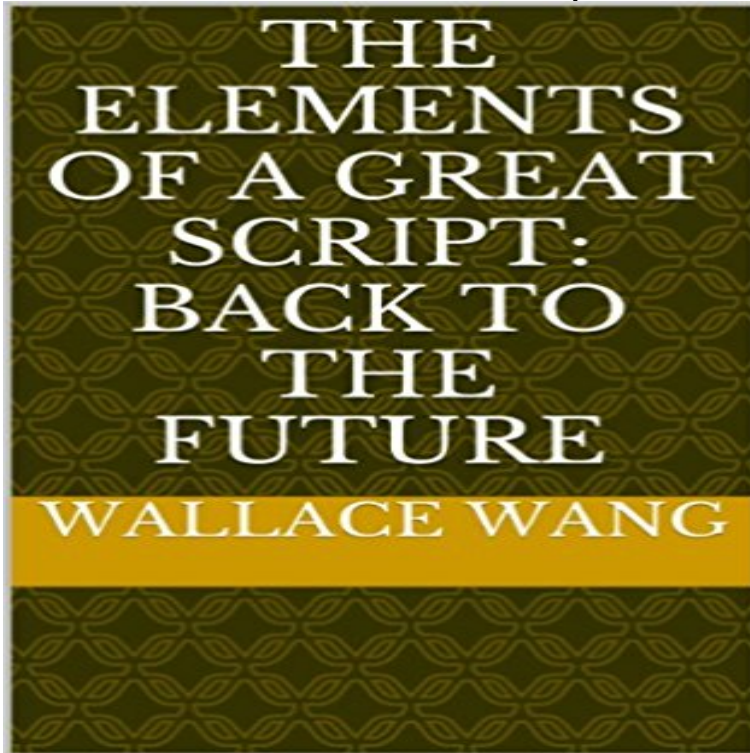


The Elements of a Great Script: Back to the Future
