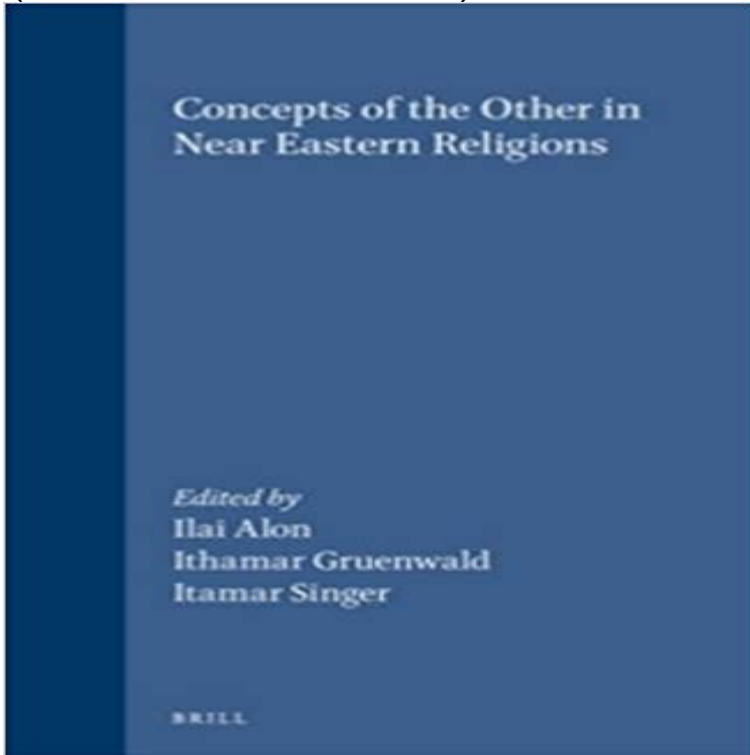


## Israel Oriental Studies: Concepts of the Other in Near Eastern Religions (Israel Oriental Studies)
