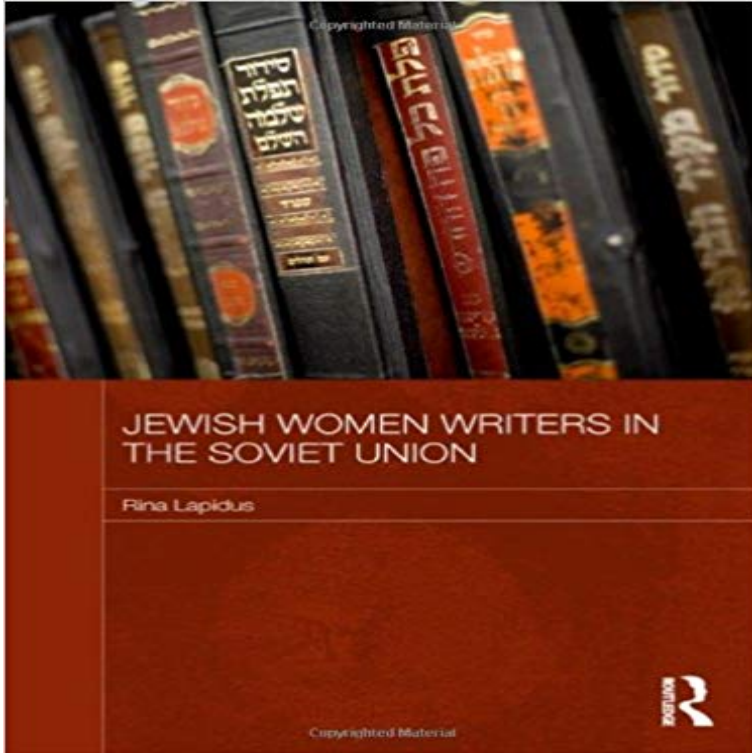


Jewish Women Writers in the Soviet Union (Routledge Studies in the History of Russia and Eastern Europe)

The works include poems, novels, memoirs and other writing. The book provides an overview of the life of each author, an overview of each authors literary output, and an assessment of each authors often conflicted view of her feminine self and of her Jewish self. At a time when the large Jewish population which lived within the Soviet Union was threatened under Stalins prosecutions the book provides highly-informative insights into what it was like to be a Jewish woman in the Soviet Union in this period.
